Introduction

Government of Sindh's decision of adopting a centralized admission policy for the province towards strengthening the rule of merit, ensuring transparency and fairness across the province. A candidate aspiring for admission in a medical institution anywhere in the province, has to fill a single form (according to tagged district allocation) and appear in one entrance test only which will ensure a fair chance and equal opportunity to students from all over the province.

This year, Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences, Jamshoro is hosting the admission process. This prospectus is an introduction to all the public medical institutions of Sindh. It contains rules and regulations concerning admissions, administration, and examinations etc.

1. The rules in this prospectus shall apply to all the Sindh government medical universities and affiliated colleges namely:
 - i. **Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences (LUMHS), Jamshoro.**
 - ii. **Dow University of Health Sciences (DUHS), Karachi.**
 - iii. **Jinnah Sindh Medical University (JSMU), Karachi.**
 - iv. **Peoples University of Medical and Health Sciences for Women (PUMHSW), Shaheed Benazirabad.**
 - v. **Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical University (SMBBMU), Larkana.**
 - vi. **Karachi Medical and Dental College, Karachi.**
 - vii. **Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical College (SMBBMC), Lyari, Karachi.**
 - viii. **Gambat Medical College, PAQS Jilani Institute of Medical Sciences, Gambat, and**
 - ix. **Khairpur Medical College, District Khairpur.**
2. All these institutions offer 05 and 04 years study programmes leading to MBBS and BDS degree respectively.
3. All the universities offer co-education except PUMHS, Shaheed Benazirabad where only girls are admitted.
4. One or more hospitals are attached to each medical university for clinical teaching. The clinical professors, associate, and assistant professors of the University are also consultants in the attached teaching hospitals.
5. Students enrolled in these universities are bound to abide by the rules and regulations as laid down in this prospectus.

LIAQUAT UNIVERSITY OF MEDICAL & HEALTH SCIENCES (LUMHS)

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences (LUM&HS) Jamshoro is the first ever public sector medical university with a long history of imparting quality medical education in the region. It started as a medical school in the present Civil Hospital, Hyderabad, Sindh in 1881 the first ever medical institution in the province of Sindh. After the separation of Sindh from the Bombay Presidency, this school was upgraded to the status of a medical college to impart teaching for MBBS under Bombay University.

The Medical College at Hyderabad Sindh was inaugurated by Sir Francis Moody, first Governor of Sindh and the first batch of forty-five students including one Muslim female student were admitted. The College was then shifted to Karachi on 10th December, 1945 and was renamed as Dow Medical College. Subsequently, Government of Sindh started another college in the same Civil Hospital, Hyderabad premises in 1951, which was named as Liaquat Medical College (LMC) after the first Prime Minister of Pakistan, Mr. Liaquat Ali Khan. The LMC was affiliated with the University of Sindh.

In its journey of more than 68 years, the College has made tremendous contributions in both medical education and healthcare in the province and the country. The LMC shifted to its new, beautiful, and spacious campus at Jamshoro in 1963. Initially, it offered the MBBS course only. The Dental Section imparting education and training for the degree of Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) was added in 1963. In the same year, the college also started postgraduate courses. The number of postgraduate courses expanded gradually and the college acquired the status of a postgraduate medical institute in 1989. Besides, it became a recognized institution of the training for FCPS and MCPS in almost all disciplines of medicine, surgery, dentistry, and allied sciences. It also received recognition from accreditation bodies of foreign countries such as British General Medical Council of United Kingdom, Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) of USA, and similar bodies of several other countries. The College has made significant contribution in postgraduate medical education and has produced more than 1200 specialists in various disciplines of clinical and basic sciences with postgraduate qualifications of MD, MS, MPhil, MPH, and Diplomas. It was this outstanding

contribution that upon comprehensive inspection and recommendation of the former University Grants Commission, now Higher Education Commission (HEC), and after prolonged deliberations at the highest fora of provincial government, the honourable governor of Sindh promulgated Liaquat University Ordinance on 20th January 2001, upgrading the Liaquat Medical College to Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences, a unique distinction indeed of being the first ever medical university in public sector of the country.

INSTITUTE OF DENTISTRY

The Institute of Dentistry was originally established in the Liaquat Medical College in the year 1963 as the second oldest but the largest institute in the country. With the upgradation of Liaquat Medical College (LMC) to the status of University i.e. Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences (LUMHS), the dental section was upgraded as an Institute of Dentistry. Since its inception, the Institute of Dentistry, Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences, Jamshoro has been continuously focusing on its academic excellence to provide quality dentistry care to all sectors of society and at the same time providing the community with qualified dental specialists. As a result, the Institute of Dentistry is recognized for its quality undergraduate and postgraduate courses by Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC) and College of Physicians & Surgeons, Pakistan (CPSP). Postgraduate courses like Master of Science (MSc) in all clinical disciplines including FCPS-II, Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Operative Dentistry, Prosthodontics, and FCPS Orthodontics speciality are also being offered in this institution.

Peoples Nursing School

Peoples Nursing School is the first ever public sector institute set up in Pakistan to provide quality nursing education to deserving students to acquire in-depth knowledge and essential skills. The Institute of Nursing is housed in a beautifully built premises constructed with generous funding provided by the Higher Education Commission (HEC).

Institute of Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation Sciences

The Institute of Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation Sciences, was established in February, 2009. A dire need existed of establishing the Institution of Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation Sciences to impart



quality medical education dealing with physical therapy, occupational and speech language therapy for relieving pain and regaining strength after serious injuries, illnesses and surgeries. From the date of its establishment the institute has been extending quality care to the patients. This institute offers a five-year degree programme in Doctor of Physiotherapy (DPT).

Institute of Bio-Medical Engineering & Technology

The need for biomedical experts has been felt in Sindh for a long time. In order to meet this need, the University decided to establish an institute of biomedical engineering and technology to integrate academics with practical skills in order to produce genuine biomedical engineers. The dream came true and the Institute of Biomedical Technology was established in March, 2009. The institute has started a BS programme in Biomedical Engineering from 2012, recognized by the Higher Education Commission (HEC) and Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC). This programme consists of four years including eight semesters, with two semesters per year. The aim behind the establishment of this institute was to create diligent and proficient engineers as well as to create jobs opportunities in public sector organizations including hospitals, universities, etc.

College of Pharmacy

LUMHS College of Pharmacy strives to support the profession of pharmacy's vision for practice, research, and education by providing an environment that prepares a continuing stream of new pharmacists well-prepared to deliver evidence-based medication therapy management and other pharmacy and health-related services as a part of interdisciplinary teams dedicated to patient-centered care and the general well-being of the public and inculcates the commitment and collective participation of faculty, students, and other stakeholders (such as alumni, members of the Council of Overseers and University Officers) towards fostering innovation in practice, advancement of the basic, clinical and translational sciences, application of new educational strategies, and engagement of other healthcare professionals from across the disciplines.

Explanation Notes on Reserved Seats

Two (02) seats in MBBS course at the Fatima Jinnah Medical College (FJMC) Lahore are reserved for girl candidates.

LUMHS selection center shall select two (02) girl candidates for reserved seats at Fatima Jinnah Medical College, Lahore, either on merit-cum-choice basis from selection or from upper waiting merit general pool of tagged districts of LUMHS on option basis.

Two (02) seats at BMC, Quetta, Balochistan on reciprocal basis from LUMHS

Two (02) candidates from LUMHS selection center shall be selected for admission in MBBS course at Bolan Medical College Quetta, either by choice from selection or from upper waiting general pool on option basis.

One (1) seat of MBBS course at AJK Medical College, Muzaffarabad

One candidate from LUMHS selection center shall be selected for admission in MBBS course at AJK Medical College, Muzaffarabad, either by choice from selection or from upper waiting general pool on option basis.

In case a seat falls vacant in above categories due to selection based on merit-cum-choice, it shall be filled by admitting the next candidate from upper merit waiting from the same district.

University Education Assistance Programme (UEAP)

Fifteen (15) seats in MBBS and fifteen (15) seats in BDS as mentioned in "Distribution of seats of tagged Districts with LUMHS" have been reserved for local students on University Educational Assistance Programme (UEAP), subject to criteria and other formalities for admission as prescribed in the prospectus. The candidates who will apply for admission in MBBS/BDS course under UEAP self-finance, will be considered on merit. In case a general merit seat falls vacant before closing of admission, the candidate shall be considered on general merit seat as per merit.

University Development Programme (UDP)
Twenty Nine (29) seats in MBBS as mentioned in "Distribution of seats of tagged Districts in MBBS as mentioned in University Development Programme LUMHS" have been reserved for local students on University Development Programme subject to criteria and other formalities for admission as prescribed in the prospectus candidates who will apply for admission in MBBS course under UDP self-finance considered as per merit.

Reserved Seats Under Overseas Category for the Children of Overseas Pakistanis
Four (04) seats in MBBS have been reserved for the children of Overseas Pakistanis domiciles of Sindh Province, subject to criteria and other formalities for admission as prescribed in the prospectus.

Option once given shall be final.
Once a candidate exercises an option for a seat on merit-cum-choice basis and fails to avail the same, his/her admission shall stand cancelled and will not be considered on open merit.

Seats for Balochistan Province
Four (04) seats for MBBS programme, two (02) on reciprocal basis and two (02) on Government of Balochistan basis are reserved for the students of Balochistan Province. The nominations will be made by the Health Department, Government of Balochistan for admission at LUMHS Jamshoro. The criteria of their admissions must be followed by the eligibility, rules, and regulations of this University and PM&DC.

Disabled Candidates
Candidates for admission against the seats reserved for disabled persons, after having failed to be selected against the district merit seats on the basis of their overall merit, will have to produce a certificate from the Department of Social Welfare, Government of Sindh, Karachi or Civil Services Hospital to the effect.

A Medical Board shall be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences, Jamshoro to examine the candidates and establish the degree of disability of the candidates. Disabled candidates shall be selected as per merit list of the disabled candidates provided by the board.

Hostel Fee

- Hostel fee will remain the same for all courses (MBBS/BDS/Bio Med./Physiotherapy / D-Pharm, BSN etc.) held by University except for PGs and house officers.
- Candidates are supposed to deposit hostel fee at the time of admission.

A) Al-Tibri International Hostel (for Boys)

- Room Charges Rs. 4,400/- per month
 - Air-Conditioner Charges (1-ton split) Rs. 7,700/- per month
- Payment may be received in advance for whole 3 month / 6 months.

B) Other Hostels (for boys and girls)

- Admission fee (once at the time of allotment) Per year Rs. 5,000/-
- Room rent (incl. electric and water charges) Per year Rs. 7,000/-
- Identity Card fee Per year Rs. 100/-

RESERVED SEATS FOR CHILDREN OF PAKISTANIS LIVING ABROAD

Six (06) seats, as mentioned in Distribution of seats in Peoples University of Medical & Health Sciences for Women, Shaheed Benazirabad have been reserved for children of Pakistanis living abroad subject to criteria and other formalities for admissions to MBBS course as prescribed in the Prospectus.

Application for these seats will be forwarded / attested by Pakistan's embassies abroad and will be submitted to Head of the Institution. (Applications for this category will be received after the display of Final Merit List).

EXPLANATION NOTES

- i. One hundred Sixty five (165) girl students shall be admitted to PUMHSW Nawabshah. Once a candidate opt for a seat on merit basis and fails to avail the same, her admission shall stand cancelled & will not be considered on open merit if some seats fall vacant. All those candidates who have applied on UDP (Local) will be first considered on General Merit.
- ii. Candidates for all Foreign National seats under PTAP are to be nominated by the Government of Pakistan, Ministry of Economic Affairs Division, Islamabad.

OPTIONS ONCE GIVEN SHALL BE FINAL

Once a candidate exercises an option for a seat on open merit basis OR on self financing seat and fails to avail the same, his/ her admission shall stand cancelled & will not be considered.

ELIGIBILITY

- Candidate for admission must have Permanent Residence Certificate on Form 'C' and Domicile certificate in a respective Towns / Districts / Divisions of Sindh province tagged to Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical College Lyari, Karachi.
- Whereas there is no Allocated, Reserve / Special seat available for any other province/overseas as per policy of Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical College Lyari, Karachi in the course of M.B.B.S. like FATA, Gilgit Baltistan etc.
- Documents submitted at the time of submission of Forms will be Considered Genuine credential of students.. No change / alternate of Domicile / PRC or other any documents in current or next year for admission will be acceptable. In case candidate found in possession of more than one Domicile his/her admission will be cancelled and hence this type of claims have neither legal values nor is challengeable in any court of law and authorities. This act of change / alternate disqualify the student from admission in the current session and next.

- Strictly notify that after the display of Final Merit List the student will be eligible for the admission in the First year M.B.B.S. Course in current session after authenticated verification of Domicile/PRC from concerned authority of previous Towns/Districts/ Divisions and other educational documents. If after verification Domicile / PRC / Educational documents appear to be fake or students will not appear bonafide resident of residential jurisdiction of concerned Town / District / Division. The admission will be deemed to be cancelled and any type of claim have neither legal value nor is challengeable in any court of law and next candidate on merit will be considered for admission.
- After displaying of final merit list, admission will be finalized after verification of domicile/ PRC of concerned towns (and Relevant Documents). Any Candidates found using Domicile/P.R.C. of more than one Town/ District/ Division, or domicile obtained on false credentials or of other province in Pakistan shall be disqualified for admission in this college forever and is liable for prosecution under the standing laws.
- Domicile Certificate and CNIC from NADRA of Father/ Mother / Guardian should be from Sindh Province. The domicile certificate of mother shall only be accepted in case where father has expired and no such certificate was issued to him OR there has been remarriage / separation for which a valid document from the Court has been produced. Domicile certificate and CNIC from NADRA of the candidate can also be accepted either if he/ she has attained the age of 18 years or both the parents are not alive (supported by death certificate) and no such certificate was issued to him. In this case guardian domicile (from Sindh Province) should be submitted.
- All admissions are provisional subject to verification of Documents, Domicile / PRC submitted by the candidate and also the correct observance of the rules. If at any stage, even after the final merit list or the start classes of academic session, it is proved that the candidate has been admitted on the basis of false incorrect documents or information or having double Domicile/ PRC or against the rules of admission, his/her admission shall be cancelled immediately by the institution concerned after giving him/her a genuine / legal opportunity to show cause (within Seven days) and all fees paid by him/her shall not be forfeited if found guilty.
- The date of admission in First year MBBS course shall be taken to be the first day of the corresponding academic year, irrespective of the fact as to when candidate has been selected for admission in the institution.
- The rules and regulations for holding different professional examination for M.B.B.S. course shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations framed by the Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PMDC) & university where college is affiliated for the Degree course of M.B.B.S. or amended from time to time and as approved by the Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical College Lyari Karachi.

SUSPENSION & RUSTICATION:

- The Principal of medical college is empowered to suspend, rusticate or expel any student.
- A student whose name appears in F.I.R pertaining to a non-bailable offence as specified in the Criminal Procedure Code (CPC) will be suspended. During the pendency of the case he/she will not be allowed to attend classes or take up any examination.

3. A student shall be liable for suspension up to six months if he/she commits any of the following acts:
 - a. Misbehaves or quarrels with any teacher or member of the college staff.
 - b. Spreads false rumors and inappropriate use of Social media against college administration and incites other students to violence.
 - c. Taking forceful possession, makes unauthorized use or damages any college property.
 - d. Adopting unfair means in an examination.
 - e. Any other acts which the Principal or the Executive Committee may construe as breach of discipline.

Expulsion:

A student will be expelled from the college if he commits any of the following acts and this order shall be final and irrevocable.

- a. is found in possession of firearms or lethal weapons or narcotic drugs in the college premises, examination halls and teaching hospitals or any areas specified by the Principal,
- b. remains absent for more than three months without permission of the college Principal & his admission shall be deemed to be canceled.
- c. If convicted by a court of law for any criminal act.

RULES FOR MIGRATION

No migration either external or internal in any circumstances is allowed during the whole MBBS course in this Institute.

All the selected candidates should submit the Affidavit duly sign alongwith his / her guardians at the time of admission that student will not apply / approach for migration any time during the course of studies, if he / she shall fail to abide the oath, defying and commit breach against the submitted affidavit, he / she will be liable of cancellation of admission immediately and all fees paid by him / her shall be forfeited according to Rules of Admission.

RULES OF PAYMENT OF FEES

1. Any fee deposited is non-refundable.
2. Total tuition fee per annum has to be deposited at the time of admission.
3. Fee of all categories will increase by 10% every year.
4. Fee is subjected to be revision by the Medical College / University at any time during the course of the study, due to unavoidable circumstances.

8. No installation / No part of total amount of Tuition Fee / Self-Finance fee is allowed.

ELIGIBILITY OF THE CANDIDATES

In accordance with PM&DC regulations 2018 as amended on 30th May, 2019.

- The minimum educational qualification of candidates for admission to the First Year MBBS/BDS course under all admission categories must be passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examinations HSSC (Pre Medical) or equivalent examination with at least "70%" unadjusted marks duly certified by IBCC. Candidates obtaining less than 70% marks in HSSC (Pre-Medical) or equivalent Examinations are not eligible to apply for admission.
- Candidates for admission under the categories of general merit, merit-cum-choice, UEDP, UEAP, UDP and disabled seats must be having Permanent Residence and Domicile certificates of respective tagged districts of Sindh. His / her father/mother (in case of death of the father/divorce) must also be holding domicile of Sindh province. Successful candidates will be admitted in institute as per tagged district on merit-cum-choice basis, and in case of Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical College, Lyari Karachi, please specify the town as well.
- The candidate shall apply for admission by submitting his/her SSC, HSSC or F.Sc. and his/her admission test result. The merit list shall be prepared by a weightage formula as under:-
 - F.Sc (pre Medical)/ HSSC/ Equivalent, 50%.
 - Admission test 50%.
- Provided that no candidate shall be considered eligible on merit if the student has not acquired a minimum of 60% marks in the Admissions Test and the minimum 70% unadjusted marks in HSSC (Pre Medical) or equivalent examination and obtained an aggregate merit of not less than 70% for MBBS and 60% for BDS.
- Candidates for admission under category of UEDP/UEAP Overseas must have documented evidence of having a Pakistani background, and getting education in institute located outside Pakistan.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR OVERSEAS CANDIDATES

- Marks certificate of Secondary School Certificate/O Level Equivalence Certificate duly certified by IBCC
- Marks certificate of HSSC (Pre Medical) or equivalent examination Certificate with minimum 70% unadjusted marks duly certified by IBCC.
- The candidate must have studied last two years from institutions outside Pakistan.
- SAT-II examination score with minimum 550 marks in each of three science subjects, i.e. Biology, Chemistry, and either Physics or Maths OR Foreign MCAT with minimum score of 500.
- Valid TOEFL or IELTS with a score of 500 or 5.5 or certification by (NUML).
- Candidate applying under the category of Overseas Pakistanis should submit the proof of his/her father/mother working outside Pakistan.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SELF FINANCE FOREIGN NATIONAL CANDIDATES:

- Candidates for admission under the category of foreign national require nomination by Higher Education Commission, Islamabad.
- Secondary School Certificate/O Level Equivalence Certificate from IBCC
- HSSC (Pre-Medical) or Equivalent examination last two years from abroad with minimum 70% unadjusted marks and equivalency, from IBCC Islamabad
- SAT-II examination score with minimum 550 marks in each of three science subjects, i.e. Biology, Chemistry, and either Physics or Maths OR MCAT with minimum score 500.
- Valid TOEFL or IELTS with a score of 500 or 5.5 (If applicable)
- Passport with valid visa and Police Registration Certificate

7. NOC issued by Ministry of Foreign Affairs of concerned country or by the concerned foreign mission in Pakistan is mandatory.
8. Candidates applying under foreign national category must have qualification from outside Pakistan.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR FATA CANDIDATES/AFGHAN NATIONALS/PTAP:

1. Foreign Nationals under Pakistan Technical Assistance Program (PTAP) will be admitted after their nomination by the Government of Pakistan, Ministry of Economic Affairs Division, Islamabad.
2. Candidates for admission under category 'Foreign Nationals/Afghan Nationals (UEDP/UEAP scheme)' require nomination by Higher Education Commission.
3. Candidates of FATA require nomination by Ministry of States and Frontier Regions, Government of Pakistan, Islamabad.
4. Secondary School Certificate/O Level Equivalence Certificate from IBCC
5. HSSC or equivalent Examination with minimum 70% unadjusted marks from IBCC Islamabad
6. SAT II examination score with minimum 550 marks in each of three sciences subjects, i.e. Biology, Chemistry, and either Physics or Math and MCAT with minimum score of 500.
7. Valid TOEFL or IELTS with a score of 550 or 5.5 (If applicable)
8. Passport with valid visa and police registration certificate
9. NOC issued by ministry of Foreign Affairs of concerned country or by the concerned foreign mission in Pakistan is mandatory.
10. Afghan refugees have qualified either SAT-II with minimum score of 550 or Entry Test.
11. FATA candidate have qualified either SAT-II with minimum score of 550 or Entry Test

ELIGIBILITY OF DISABLED CANDIDATES:

Candidates for admission against the seats reserved for disabled persons after having failed to be selected against the district merit seats on the basis of their overall merit, after the Entry Test, will have to produce a certificate from the Department of Social Welfare, Government of Sindh, Karachi or Civil Services Hospital to the effect:

1. That he/she is a disabled candidate within the meaning of disability which defines "Disability" as that degree of physical disability which puts the candidate at disadvantage as compared to a normal person for acquiring education in medical institutions, but otherwise capable of performing his/her duties satisfactorily as a medical professional.
2. That he/she is mentally fit and physically able to carry on studies and perform professional duties after qualifying MBBS.
3. His/her disability should not be of such a severe degree that makes a candidate unable to acquire medical education or work as a doctor.
4. Selection against the reserved seats for disabled persons will be made from the list of the disabled candidates strictly on combined merit basis after entry test by the concerned institute.

1. The application for admission to 1st year MBBS/BDS shall be invited through an advertisement in the leading newspapers mentioning the last date of receiving such applications. The applications received after due date shall not be accepted. The application shall be submitted through TCS.
2. Candidates are required to fill in only ONE FORM for admission in MBBS and BDS course for all categories of seats (General merit, merit-cum-choice, UEAP/UDP/Overseas and disabled seats).
3. All seats in various districts are open for competition. Nobody shall be denied admission on the ground of gender, religion, colour, and caste.
4. Competition in each district shall take place among candidates of that district (same District) thus a candidate from one district shall not compete with a candidate of other districts.
5. Application form and the Prospectus can be obtained from designated outlets of TCS.
6. Candidate are required to submit application forms alongwith non refundable processing fees of Rs. 1500/- (rupees fifteen hundred submitted in Habib Bank (voucher available in the prospectus) All documents should be duly attested by a government officer of grade 17 or above.
7. Application form determined by the Government (Tagged Districts).
8. Domicile Certificate of candidate (Tagged Districts).
9. Domicile Certificate of father / mother (in case of death of father or divorce) from Sindh Province.
10. Computerized National Identity Card of Father / Mother from NADRA (in case of death of father or divorce)
11. Hafiz-e-Quran Certificate (If applicable) from any madrasa registered by Wifaqul Madaris.

16. Candidates applying under the category of Overseas Pakistanis should submit the proof of his/her father/mother working outside the Pakistan.

NOTE: Any candidate found having Domicile/P.R.C. of more than one district/province in Pakistan shall be disqualified for admission in any medical institution of Sindh.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Application Form with all relevant documents must be properly filled & tagged district should be clearly mentioned.

2. Candidates are required to submit the file/envelope containing the filled application form and the required documents at the designated courier centers. Candidates should be very careful regarding their tagged district.
3. Candidates are also required mandatorily to fill online application form (Available on websites of all respective universities as mentioned in application form), in addition to submitting the hard copy of Application Form.
4. Applications shall be submitted in the prescribed printed form and its columns must be filled correctly. Incomplete forms are liable to be rejected.
5. Copies of relevant documents duly attested must be submitted as per schedule given at the end of the prospectus. No application form shall be entertained after the closing date.
6. The Admission Committee shall have the discretion to cancel the admission of candidate, who indulges in violence, uses abusive language or becomes insolent or misbehaves with any member of the Admission Committee throughout the process.
7. The Provisional merit of the candidate is liable to be corrected, if required at any stage and no candidate whose name appears in the provisional list shall claim admission on that basis.
8. No documents (Marks certificate, Revised Marks certificate, Domicile, PRC, CNIC, etc) will be entertained after prescribed date.
9. All admissions are provisional, subject to verification of original documents submitted by the candidate or rectification of any technical error. No compensation will be offered to the candidate. If at any stage it is proved that the candidate has been admitted on the basis of false or forged documents or information or against the merit or rules of admission, his/her admission shall be cancelled immediately after giving him/her an opportunity to show cause and the fee deposited (if any), shall be forfeited and University will have the right to take legal action against the candidate as per rules.
10. Only girl candidates will be admitted in PUMHSW, Shaheed Benazirabad (Nawabshah) on merit cum choice basis on allocated seats of tagged districts.
11. The day one of the commencement of classes will be considered as the beginning of the academic year.
12. Seats which remain vacant at the time of selection, shall be filled by admitting the next candidate on merit list from the same district. District merit is strictly maintained according to district quota; if the seat still remains vacant, the same shall be filled by consideration of candidates on combined merit from the tagged districts. In case a seat falls vacant during the first ninety (90) days of the academic year of admission, the same shall be filled by adopting the aforesaid procedure. Any seat falling vacant thereafter shall not be filled and shall stand forfeited.
13. The selected candidates shall get themselves enrolled with the institution on payment of requisite fees within a period of one week, failing which his/her admission will be cancelled, and next candidate on merit will be offered the seat.
14. Candidates who are finally selected on open merit seat, UEDP or any other category allowed provisional admission shall have to pledge through an affidavit that they will complete the course of MBBS of five (05) years, and BDS of four (04) years as the case maybe. In case they leave the university before completing the course for any reason, they will submit a pay order of Rs. 300,000/- (Rupees Three Lac only) for open merit candidate and Rs. 500,000/- (Rupees five lac only) for all candidate of UEDP/UEAP/UDP in favour of the respective university as a penalty for wasting a precious seat.

15. Original documents (Matric/O Level Certificate, Matric/O Level Mark sheet, Intermediate/A Level provisional certificate, Intermediate/A Level Mark sheet, Candidate Domicile, Candidate PRC and Father's Domicile) of the selected candidates will remain in the custody of the respective university till the completion of the course or the expulsion of the candidate due to any reason.
16. Those candidates who will be selected for admission under UEAP, UDP, Overseas Pakistani, Foreign Nationals and Afghan Nationals will not be converted in District merit seat after enrollment at any stage of the course
17. Selected candidates shall have to deposit fee & all mentioned documents within 7 days after displaying the final selection list, otherwise their names will be cancelled without any notice and no claim will be considered.
18. Those students who are studying in the 1st Year MBBS/BDS course against any seat of tagged districts are not entitled to apply for admission in the session 2019-2020. If any selected student of previous batch will re-apply for admission, his/her application will be rejected and university will have the right to take legal proceedings against that student.
19. Grace marks shall be dealt as per board declaration i.e.
 - (i). If percentage is made after inclusion of grace marks shall be considered in calculation of merit.
 - (ii). If percentage is made without inclusion of grace marks shall not be considered in calculation of merit.

TEACHING SYSTEM AND PROMOTION/ DROPOUT CRITERIA

1. DUHS, JSMU, KMDC & SMBBMC (Lyari) are following Integrated Modular Teaching System and annual examination is implemented.
2. LUMHS, PUMHSW (Nawabshah) & Khairpur Medical College, Khairpur are following conventional teaching system and annual examination system is implemented.
3. SMBBMU (Larkana) & Gambat Medical

College, Gambat are following conventional teaching system and annual examination system is implemented.

4. Any student who fails to clear any professional examination in two consecutive chances shall not be eligible for continuation of medical and dental studies in the subsequent professional examinations.

RULES FOR MIGRATION

The following categories of students will not be allowed for migration:

1. Those who are admitted against:
 - (a) Reserved/Reciprocal seats
 - (b) Overseas/UEDP/UDP/UEAP under Self-Finance
2. Those who are admitted on the basis of merit cum-choice/reciprocal in the university not tagged to their district of domicile including those admitted in FJMC Lahore/BMC Quetta
3. Those who have not passed the First Professional MBBS examination (Parts I and II both) and those who have not passed the First professional BDS examination.
4. Migration of students to and from the private medical colleges/universities is not allowed under any circumstances.

Those students who do not fall in the above categories shall be allowed for migration if they fulfill the following requirements:

1. NOC from Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC) is mandatory.

2. On mutual exchange basis between students of same class after passing (1st Professional Examination Part-I-II).
3. Once during the entire period of medical education of a student
4. Student who gets NOC from other recipient university/medical college or provincial government, out of Sindh Province, thus the seat falling vacant on this unilateral migration, will be forfeited.
5. Migration fee of Rs. 100,000/- (Rupees One Lac Only) will be charged by each university (relieving and admitting) from the student.
6. All scholarships/financial assistance shall be cancelled once the student migrates to another college/institution and is not transferable.

7. The migrated student shall not claim any compensation for the loss of time due to differences in starting/ending of academic sessions in examination scheduled between concerned institutions.

8. Migration is only possible when there is any vacant seat available in the recipient institute so that the total number of seats do not exceed the designated quota.

Note:

1. Migration is not possible if the curriculum being followed in both universities is different (Integrated Modular and

conventional)

2. Migration to public or private medical institution will not be allowed to any student once admitted at Peoples University of Medical & Sciences for Women, Nawabshah, Shaheed Benazirabad, and Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical College, Lyari, Karachi.

MEDICAL BOARD FOR SELECTED CANDIDATES

Selected candidates shall have to undergo a medical examination by a medical board constituted by the university. The selected candidates must produce the following investigations.

- a) X-Ray Chest (PA)

- b) Urine DR
- c) Blood C.P. + ESR
- d) Vaccination certificate against HBV
- e) HBs Ag, HCV Ab
- f) Thalassemia Minor Screening Test
- g) HIV

SPECIAL MEDICAL BOARD FOR DISABLED CANDIDATES

A Special Medical Board for Disabled Candidates will be constituted in each

university to determine the genuineness and severity of the disability of candidate.

RULES OF PAYMENT OF FEE

- If the student wishes to leave the University/College, the deposited fee will be refunded as per PM&DC rules reproduced as under.
- Where a student has deposited fee and joins or not joins classes but, within fifteen working days on the commencement of classes, informs in writing the medical and dental institution, admitting university and the Council that he/she wishes to leave the institution, his/her seat shall be deemed to have become vacant upon furnishing of this information and he/she shall be entitled to hundred percent refund of all his/her deposited fees and charges, except one time admission fee and a student from waiting list shall be admitted against this vacant seat in accordance with merit.
- Where a student who has paid fee and joins classes opts for another medical or dental institution within three months during same admission process, that student shall be entitled for refund of fee after deduction of fee for study period availed in terms of months in that medical or dental institution and the seat shall be considered as vacant. No fee shall be refunded after three months of commencement of session.
- Fee is subject to revision by the University/Health Department Government of Sindh at any time during the course of study and will be applicable at once for all years.
- Candidates selected for admission in 1st Year MBBS/BDS under any category will have to deposit fee within one week after display of the final list, failing which their names will be cancelled without any notice and no claim will be entertained.
- The student will have to pay the prescribed fee for the remaining years at the start of each session within stipulated time period i.e. 15 days. The challan forms will be issued by the Directorate of Finance.
- The examination forms will be issued from the office of the coordinators of the concerned years.
- If any student in subsequent years fails to deposit fee/dues within stipulated time period, he/she shall not be eligible to appear in examination. If student appeared in examination without clearing dues, the Controller of Examinations will be held responsible.
- In case a student appeared in Examination with the permission of the competent authority, the Controller of Examinations will withhold the examination result till issuance of No Dues Certificate from In charge Student's Branch / Director of Finance.
- The In charge Student's Branch / Director of Finance will be responsible to collect the prescribed fee of remaining years from students. If any student fails to deposit the prescribed fee, the Directorate of Finance will issue notice to the defaulter student.
- The Director of Admissions will provide the complete data of admitted students to the concerned Department.
- Late payment will be charged as per respective university's policy.
- Convocation and Degree fee will be charged from students at the time of submission of tuition fee of final year.

WAITING LIST OF KARACHI CANDIDATES

Candidates who are interested only for open merit admissions have to submit an application to clarify their non interest in UEDP (or only open merit waiting) or if he/she does not respond on the day of self-finance

For reciprocal seats, candidates have to submit Rs. 18,700/- bank draft in favour of the respective university (to be returned if they join the respective college/university within a week of the offer). If the selected candidate does not report within a week of the offer, the next candidate on waiting list (of reciprocal candidates) will be offered this seat and

his/her admission fee draft will not be refunded. A candidate can keep his/her name in only one waiting list.

On the day of Admission (UEDP), those candidates who wish to keep their name on waiting list of UEDP have to submit bank draft of Rs. 24,200/- admission fee (refundable if the respective university could not admit within one month). Only these candidates will be considered to be interested for admission and their name will remain included in self-finance waiting list.

CLOSING DATE OF ADMISSION

- Admission to all categories will be closed ninety (90) days after start of academic session and no admission will be given in any category including the reserved seats.
- Orientation class on first day of the class after admission in first year MBBS/BDS course will be considered as the first day of corresponding academic year.
- Enrolment form will be issued after the confirmation of submitted documents within three months of the first day of academic session. Any other letter besides that will be considered fake.
- The selected candidates will be enrolled with the university by paying enrolment fee.

VACANT SEATS

- The seats which remain vacant at the time of selection will be filled by admitting the next candidate on merit under the same category.
- The time duration to respond to offer of admission is only 3 working days after receipt of a call/offer letter. Next candidate on merit shall be offered admission after lapse of stipulated time.
- The provisions made in this prospectus are liable to be modified, relaxed, or amended by the university authorities from time to time and such changes will be applicable to all concerned.
